

NCAA Clearinghouse

- Step 1: Google “*NCAA Clearinghouse*” or type www.ncaa.org
- Step 2: On the left hand side of the NCAA web page is a tool bar. Click “*Academics and Athletes*”. A drop down menu will appear on this page. Next click “*Eligibility and Recruiting*”.
- Step 3: There is good info on this page to get familiar with because as an NCAA athlete you are responsible for following these rules. Ignorance of the rules is not an excuse! On the bottom of this page in the center click on “*Eligibility Center*”.
- Step 4: On this page click “*Prospective Student Athlete*”.
- Step 5: First read “*New Rules*” section. Then go back and click on the blue box “*U.S. Students Register Here*”
- Step 6: Register! There is also good information that you are responsible for on the left side of the page. See Mr. Siegfried or your coach with questions.
- Step 7: Make Stanton Proud!
